## NEW!!! 2019 Solar Rebate Program



### Program Details

The new Marblehead Municipal Light Dept. (MMLD) Solar Rebate Program provides residential customers with a rebate of up to \$6,000 on the purchase and installation of PV solar panels on their homes.

The Program provides a solar rebate of up to \$1.20 per watt for the first 5 kilowatts of any residential project. Eligible solar installations must be 25 kilowatts or less. The solar arrays must have less than 20% shading, and facing between 90 and 270 degrees.

The Program runs through July 31, 2020 or until funds are exhausted



### How to Apply for the Rebate

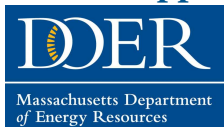
**Please first contact MMLD at 781-631-5600 for solar installation permit information**

Then submit the rebate application online with the Massachusetts Municipal Wholesale Electric Company (MMWEC), our power supply partner. The application is online at [www.mmwec.org](http://www.mmwec.org). Customers can also call 413-308-1400 to check your application status



#### Step One

The homeowner submits their online rebate application to MMWEC for review. MMWEC forwards it to the Mass Dept of Energy Resources (DOER) for final approval



#### Step Two

After the DOER evaluates the application, customers will be notified of their rebate status.

#### Step Three

Upon approval, customers have one year to schedule and complete installation of their solar panels. The rebate will be paid to the customer by MMWEC.
